



Ohio Center for Law-Related Education BEHAVIOR STANDARDS

1. Each team/group of students is required to have one adult supervisor for every 12 students that are in attendance.
 - a. Each team/group is required to have an adult supervisor of each gender who will accompany team members to restrooms.
 - b. Any cleaning costs or damage incurred in a room will result in any/all teams/groups that used the room to be billed for the cost.
2. No furniture is to be moved by a school staff member or students, this includes podiums.
 - a. Any cleaning costs or damage incurred in a room will result in any/all teams/groups that used the room to be billed for the cost.
3. Schools/teams may not request building staff to make copies or send/receive faxes for the schools/teams.
4. No gum is permitted at all times.
 - a. Any cleaning costs or damage incurred in a room will result in any/all teams/groups that used the room to be billed for the cost.
5. No school staff, students or parents are permitted to have food or beverage of any kind in the hearing rooms without permission.
 - a. Any cleaning costs or damage incurred in a room will result in any/all teams/groups that used the room to be billed for the cost.
6. Each team/group is to designate one (1) student to throw away trash, straighten chairs, etc. at the conclusion of each presentation/hearing. This equals two (2) students per room.
7. Students must be supervised outdoors: no climbing on walls or parapets or ledges.
8. Teams are strongly encouraged to write to the appropriate building officials (court personnel, Justices, legislators, etc.) thanking them for the opportunity to showcase in their building.
9. The Ohio Center for Law-Related Education reserves the right to withdraw participation privileges from schools whose students behave inappropriately.
10. Our hosts have graciously allowed us the privilege to use their facility for our event. Please remind students to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner and treat this facility as they would a museum. It is an honor to host the event at this location, and any students, school staff, or guests of the school who behave inappropriately could lead to the disqualification of their school/group and immediate dismissal from the event.
